PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO B.Ed. PROGRAMME

(For Two year B.Ed programme 2021-23 only)

1. Introduction

1.1 Candidates are required to go through the Prospectus carefully and acquaint themselves with all the relevant information relating to the online admission. Candidates are also requested to visit the websites of the Directorate of Admissions <https://admission.uoc.ac.in> regularly for notifications and announcements in respect of admission to B.Ed programme.

1.2 The prospectus issued in previous years is not valid for 2021-22 admission.

2. Programmes, Institutions and Categorization of Seats:

2.1 Details of Programmes and duration

The course will follow the general rules prescribed for the B.Ed. programme by the University of Calicut with respect to academic standards for admission, course of study, scheme of examination, instructional hours, practice teaching requirements, attendance of students, etc, with the rules and regulations of NCTE. B.Ed Programme is a professional teacher education programme. The programme extends for a period of two years/four semesters. Candidates are permitted to take additional B.Ed degree as per UO. No. 407/2021/Admn dated 11.01.2021. Candidates joining for an additional B.Ed should do the full course and there will be no relaxation in any type of theory and practical activities.

2.2. Categorization of Seats

University of Calicut has 69 colleges offering B.Ed programme (2 Govt. Colleges, 2 Aided Colleges, 11 University Teacher Education Centres and 54 Self Financing Colleges). Management seats in Aided and Unaided colleges are to be filled with qualified eligible candidates by the management concerned as per the norms issued by the Government of Kerala.

2.3 Institutions and subjects for the B.Ed programme

(c) Relaxation in teaching experience:

- (a) TTC holders /HSST (Commerce) need only one year teaching experience.
- (b) Permanent Teachers of Lakshadweep (natives)/LTTC/Diploma in Hindi Teaching/PPTTC need only two years experience.

B) Defence Quota [DQ]: One seat in each Govt./Aided/University Centre is reserved for this quota candidate. Order of priorities for reservation or preferences to the wards of Armed Forces Personnel by states/Uts/Central/State Universities/Autonomous Institutions for admission in Professional/Non-professional courses is detailed in **Appendix IV**. Applicants will have to submit the relevant certificate applicable to them in support of the claim at the time of admission.

C) Sports Quota: One seat in each Government, Aided and University Teacher Education Centres are reserved for Sports Quota candidates.

Kerala State Sports Council, Thiruvananthapuram will prepare the rank list of the candidates under sports quota for B.Ed Admission for 2019 academic year onwards based on their proficiency in Sports as per U.O. NO.6840/2019/Admn dated 27.05.2019. The candidates applying under Sports Quota for B.Ed programme under University of Calicut should send a photocopy of the online application form along with copies of the qualifying certificates and certificates obtained in Sports to 'The Secretary, Kerala State Sports Council, Thiruvananthapuram 695001'. Kerala State Sports Council, Thiruvananthapuram will forward the rank list of candidates under sports quota to University of Calicut. Email Id : keralasportscouncil@gmail.com.

D) Linguistic Minority Quota: 5 seats (within the sanctioned strength) at University Teacher Education Centre, Koduvayur are reserved for the linguistic minorities whose mother tongue is Tamil and residing in the jurisdiction of University of Calicut. 2 seats in University Teacher Education Centre, Kaniyambetta and 2 seats in University Teacher Education Centre, Sulthan Bathery (total-4 in Wayanad District) are reserved for linguistic minorities whose mother tongue is Kannada and residing in the jurisdiction of University of Calicut. The admission under Linguistic Minority Quota in above mentioned Centres is made subject to a maximum of one seat in each optional.

5.1.4 Mandatory Reservation: Leaving the seats set apart for Nominees, Persons with Disabilities and Special Reservations, the remaining seats for each course in a Govt. Colleges/University Teacher Education Centres will be distributed as per the mandatory reservation principle. Leaving the seats under reservation of seats applicable to Aided/Self-Financing Colleges, merit seats will be distributed as per mandatory reservation principle.

(a) **SC/ST reservation-** Shall be followed subject wise. Scheduled Caste - 8% of seats and Scheduled Tribe 2% of seats in each optional. In case sufficient eligible applicants under SC/ST quota are not available, the same will be filled up in the following priority.

SC seats: By ST/ OEC candidates.

ST seats: By SC/OEC candidates.

(b) Socially and Educationally Backward Classes 30%- ETB 9%, MU 8%, OBH 3%, LA 3%, DV 2 %, VK 2 %, KN 1 % OBX 1%, KU 1 %. In private Self Financing Colleges 50% of the seats will be filled up on the basis of merit and by following the reservation policy of the State Government. The remaining 50% can be filled up by the educational agency (Management quota).

(c) Seats remaining unavailed in community quota, allowed in Aided Colleges, due to non-availability of candidates in that particular college will go to general merit.

M.Ed programme (4 semester) is designed to provide opportunity for students to extend as well as deepen their knowledge and understanding of education, specialize in select areas, and also develop research capacities leading to specialization in either elementary education or secondary education. The purpose of M.Ed programme is to prepare professionally committed and competent teacher educators, curriculum developers, educational policy analysts, supervisors, school counselors, school Principals, educational administrators, and educational planners who can develop education according to the national aspirations and global trends. It seeks to prepare educational experts capable of generating knowledge and to find solutions to the problems and issues relating to the theory and practice of the varied fields of education. It also focuses on comprehensive and integrated professional development of personnel engaged in educational management and administration.

The details of colleges offering M Ed programme is shown in Annexure 1

I. Programme Regulations**I.1. Conditions for Admission****I.1.2. Eligibility:**

Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed programme shall be required to have passed the following programmes with at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade.

a) B.Ed degree of 1 or 2 years duration recognised by University of Calicut

or

b) 4 year integrated teacher education degree programme (B. El. Ed/ B. Sc. Ed/ B. A.Ed) recognised by University of Calicut*,

***(In case of Integrated degree programmes B.Sc.Ed/B.A.Ed, aggregate marks/ grade in Education Papers alone will be considered)**

A first Master's degree is not mandatory for entry in the M.Ed programme. However an additional weightage shall be given to candidates with post- graduate degree in Sciences/ Humanities/ Social Sciences

Relaxation in the marks will be allowed in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes/ Socially and Educationally Backward Classes/ Persons with disabilities and other applicable categories as per the rules of State government.

II. Reservation Criteria : Seats are reserved for Differently abled candidates and candidates belonging to SC, ST, SEBC& EWS (Forward Caste) categories as per the reservation principles of Government of Kerala as adopted by the University of Calicut. Percentage of reservation for each Category in Department of Education of University of Calicut/ Government/ Aided/ Self-financing Colleges is detailed below .

II.1. Reservation of seats for differently abled candidates: 5% seats are reserved for differently abled candidates.

II.2.Reservation of seats for Economically Weaker Sections: On the basis of G.O (M.S) No.128/2020/H.Edn dated 20.03.2020, 10% seats are reserved for Economically Weaker Sections among Forward Communities. (U.O No:7158/2020/Admn Dated,28.07.2020).

* 10% seats are additionally created over and above sanctioned intake for reservation to Economically Weaker Sections in Government and Aided and Self Financing Colleges that have no minority status.

II.3. In Aided Forward Community Colleges, 15% seats are reserved for management quota and 10% seats are reserved for Community Quota respectively. In Aided Backward Community Colleges 15% seats are reserved for Management Quota and 20% seats are reserved for Community Quota.

II.4. In self financing colleges, 50% seats are reserved as Management Quota seats.

III. Mode of selection and weightage of marks

Criteria for selection and method of admission to Merit/ Management seats for M.Ed programmes conducted by University Department of Education/ Government/ Aided/ Self Financing Colleges affiliated to University of Calicut shall be governed by the rules and regulations framed by the University of Calicut.

In all matters related to selection and admission, the decisions of the University shall be final. The students admitted by affiliated colleges violating the above regulations will not be eligible for registration to University Examinations and contravention of the regulations shall lead to suspension / withdrawal of affiliation.

IV. The selection of candidates will be based on the following criteria:

The total marks obtained for the qualifying Examination (calculated out of 1000) shall be the basis for selection .

An additional weightage shall be given to the candidates with Post Graduate Degree (MA/ M.Sc./ M.com) in the respective area of specialization at B.Ed while preparing ranklist. The weightage shall be of 15 marks for those having first class with distinction/ 10 marks for those having first class/ 5 marks for those having second class and 3 marks for those having a pass in the respective Post Graduate Examination. 15 marks weightage will be given to students who secured B.Ed Degree from University of Calicut.

Weightage of 5 marks for every year of approved teaching experience in Govt./ Aided / Recognized institutions such as Elementary Teacher Training Institute or in an Elementary/ Secondary/ Senior Secondary School subject to a maximum of 25 marks. 1 year continuous service in corresponding scale alone will be considered. The weightage shall be given on the basis of an Experience Certificate in Form IV signed by the Headmaster/ Principal which is countersigned by an authorized Official Signatory such as the AEO/DEO/DDCE/DHSE/DVHSE etc.

V. Admissions:

University will forward the Rank list of registered students to the Department/ Colleges. Department/ Colleges may be permitted to conduct admissions as per the admission schedule published by the University.

Candidates or representatives may be permitted to attend on the date prescribes for admission in the respective colleges and three days shall be given for taking admission.

VI. Fee

Fee structure will be published prior to admission in the website.

VII. Essential requirement at the time of admission

1. Printout of online application form
2. S.S.L.C/Equivalent Certificate to prove Name and Age
3. B.Ed/ Other Qualifying Examination Marklist and Certificate to prove Educational Qualifications
4. P.G. Marklist and Certificate to prove weightage (if any)
5. Service Certificate in Form IV (duly signed by competent authority) to prove service weightage(if any)

6. EWS certificate for **Forward Caste** (issued by Revenue Authorities.)
7. Caste certificate for SC/ST candidates
8. Non-Creamy Layer Certificate / Community Certificate for eligible candidates
9. Disability Certificate for Physically / Visually Challenged Candidates

VIII.Duration of the Programme

The M Ed degree programme shall extent over a period of two academic year comprising of four semesters.The maximum duration permissible for taking the degree course is fixed as 3 years. The minimum number of working days in each semester shall be 100 and in each year shall be 200 excluding days of admission.

IX.Attendance

A candidate shall be permitted to appear for the end semester examinations only if he/ she satisfies the following requirements .He/She maintains not less than 80% attendance in the total number of working days in each semester for theory and practical and not less than 90% attendance for internship. Shortage of attendance shall not be condoned more than twice during the entire course. Candidate who is not eligible for condonation of shortage of attendance shall repeat the semester by seeking readmission.

X.Registration for each semester

All the courses carrying credits should be compulsorily attended by all the candidates for the successful completion of the course. Only such candidates are permitted to register for the End Semester University Examination. Every candidate should register for all subjects of the End Semester Examinations of each semester. A candidate who does not register will not be permitted to attend the End Semester Examinations; he/she shall not be permitted to attend the next semester. A candidate shall be eligible to register for any higher semester, if he/ she has satisfactorily completed the course of study and registered for the examination of the immediate previous semester. He/ she should register for the semester before the stipulated date. University will notify the starting and closing dates for each semester.

XI.Procedure for completing the course

A candidate shall be required to complete the M.Ed programme after undergoing the prescribed courses of study in a college affiliated to the University of Calicut for four semesters within a period not less than two years and clear all the examinations prescribed and fulfill all such conditions as prescribed by the University from time to time. However the maximum duration permissible for taking the M.Ed programme is fixed as 3 years after joining the course. A candidate shall not be allowed to improve the marks already obtained. However cancellation and reappearance along with the regular examination will be permitted.
